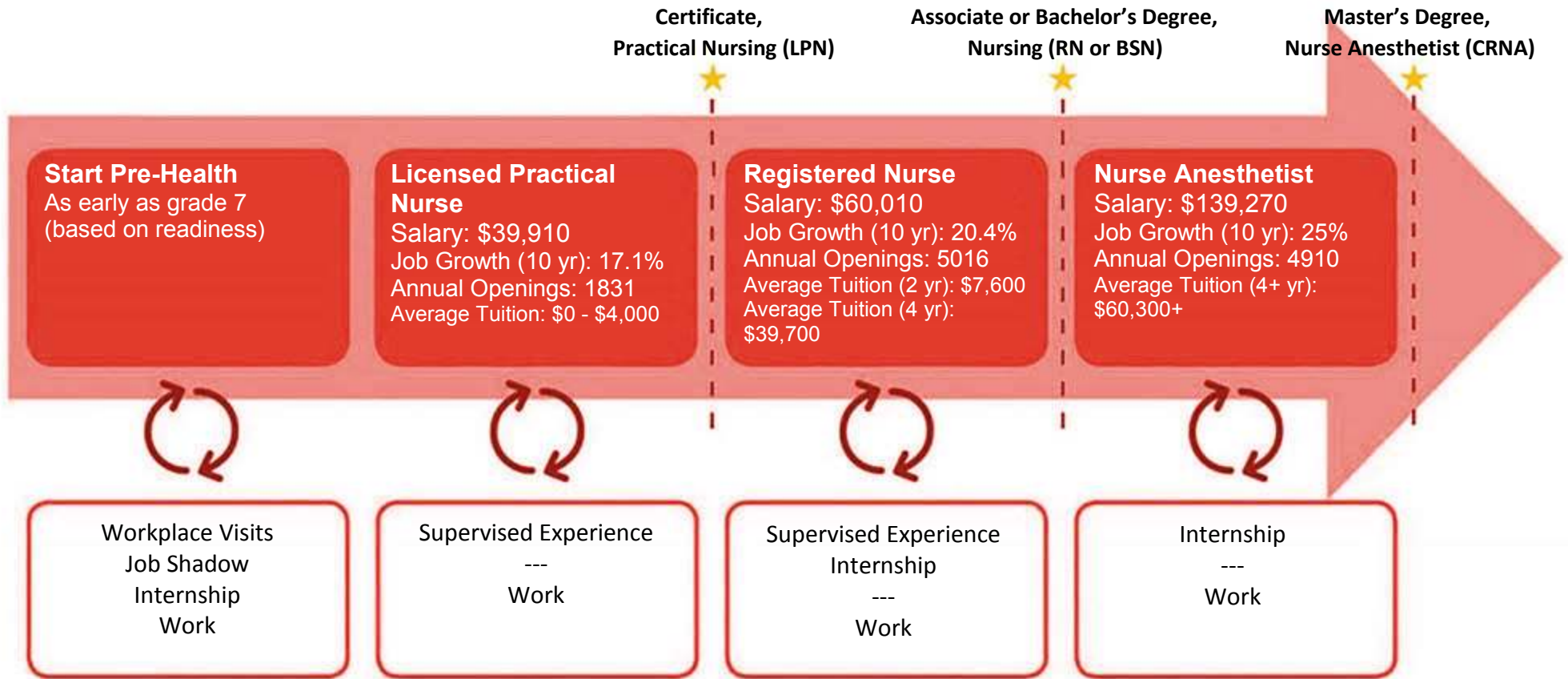




Health Science Pathway Model
